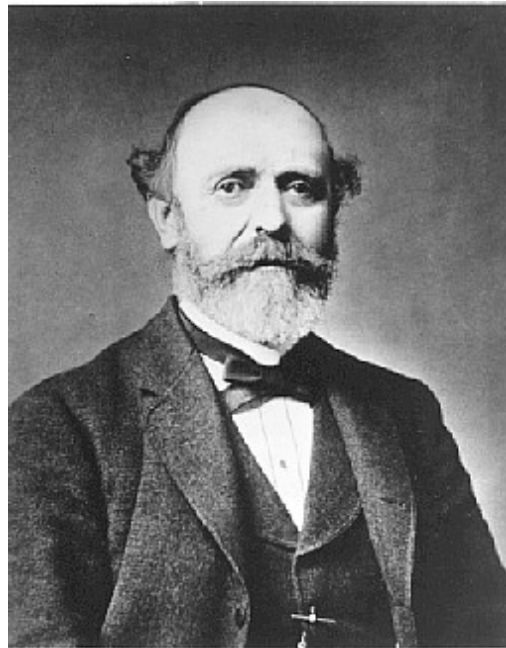

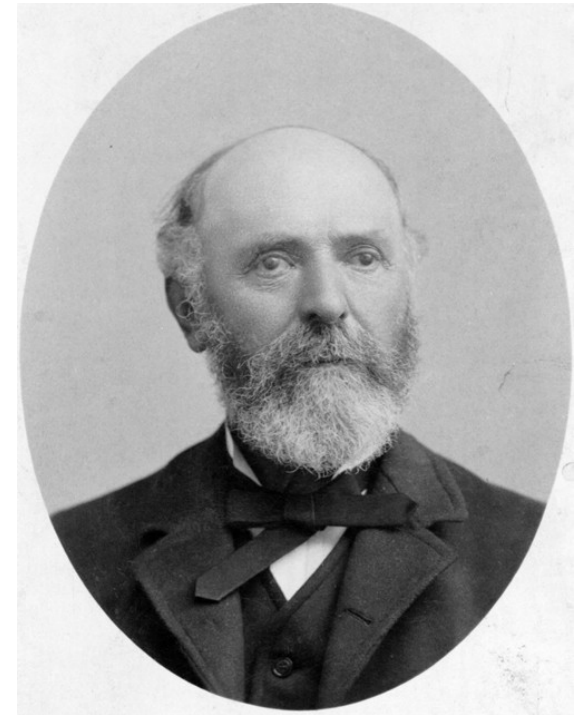

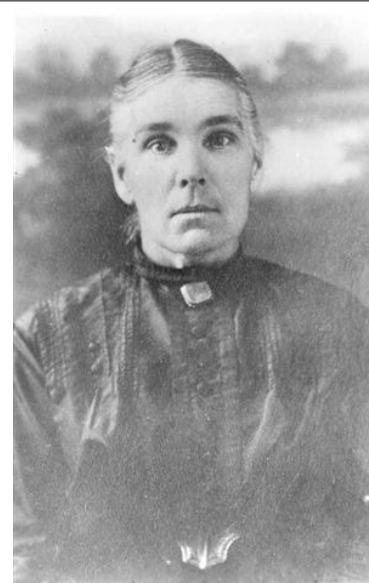

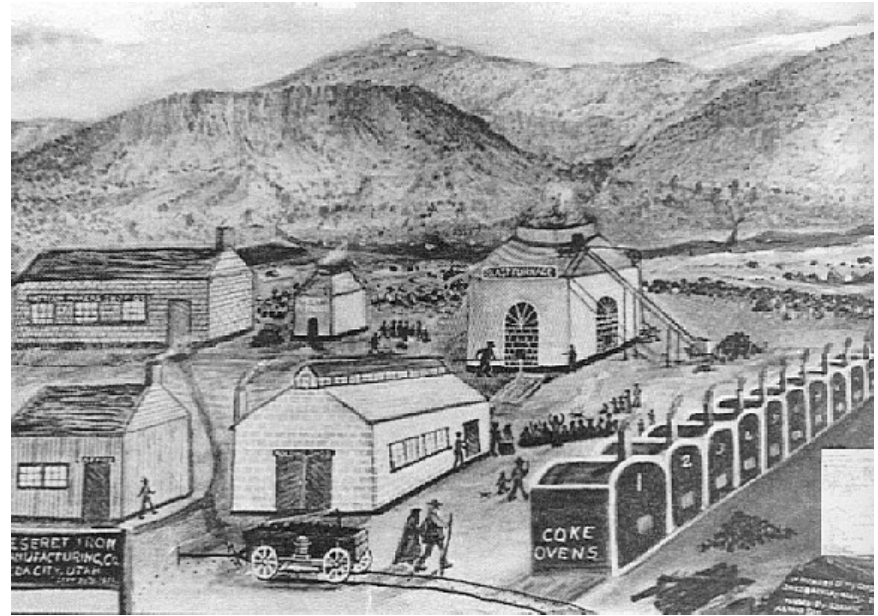

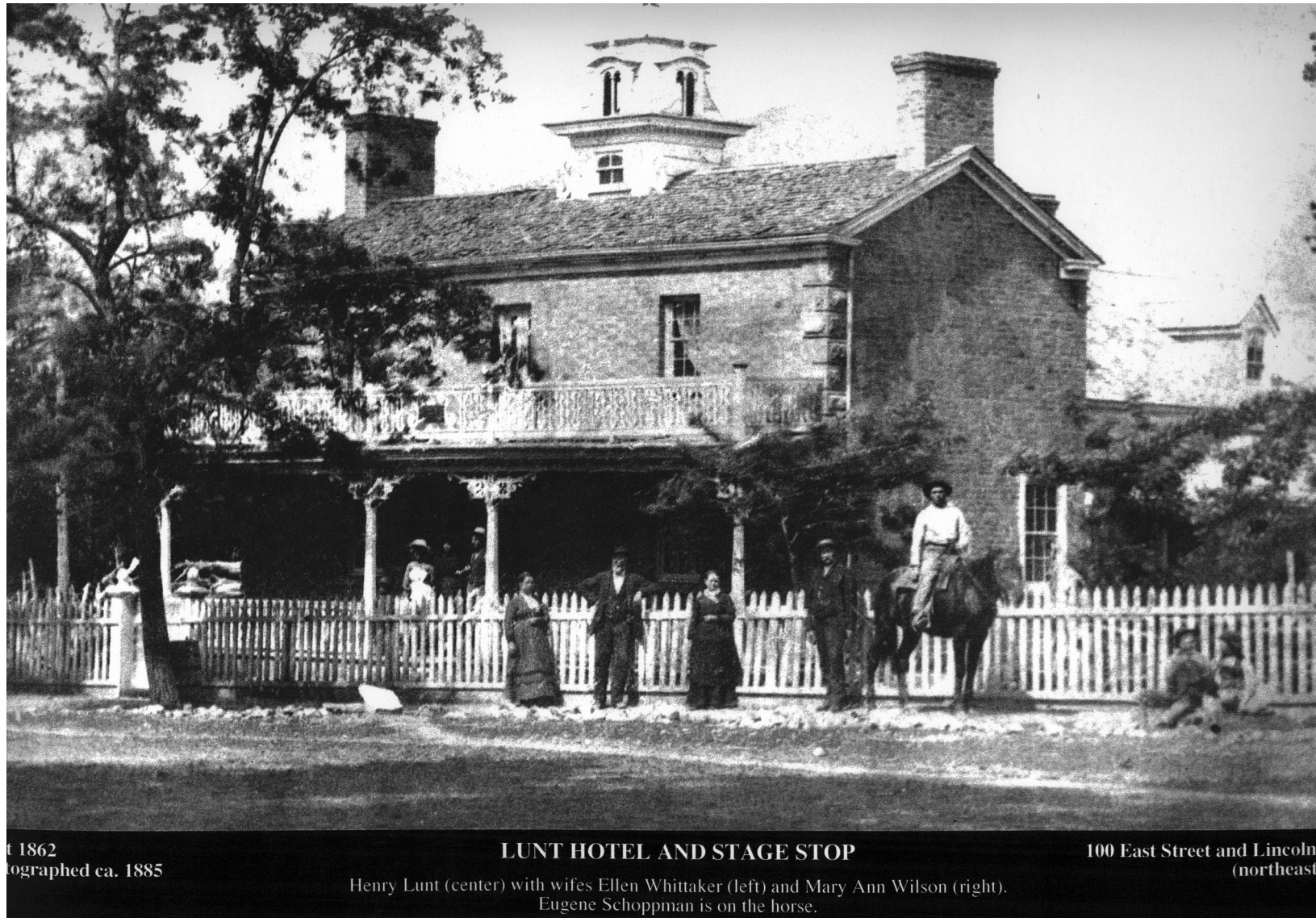


Statue of Henry Lunt in front of the Cedar City Offices at 10 North Main Street. Henry was a founder and one of the civic and religious leaders in Cedar City.
